

## Sin

Bible	Text
Deuteronomy 18:9-11	<p><b>9 “When you come into the land which the Lord your God is giving you, you shall not learn to follow the abominations of those nations. 10 There shall not be found among you anyone who makes his son or his daughter pass through the fire, or one who practices witchcraft, or a soothsayer, or one who interprets omens, or a sorcerer, 11 or one who conjures spells, or a medium, or a spiritist, or one who calls up the dead.</b></p>
Psalm 1:1	<p>Blessed <i>is</i> the man          Who walks not in the counsel of the ungodly,          Nor stands in the path of sinners,          Nor sits in the seat of the scornful;</p>
Romans 1:18-32	<p><sup>18</sup> For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who suppress the truth in unrighteousness, <sup>19</sup> because what may be known of God is manifest in them, for God has shown <i>it</i> to them. <sup>20</sup> For since the creation of the world His invisible <i>attributes</i> are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, <i>even</i> His eternal power and Godhead, so that they are without excuse, <sup>21</sup> because, although they knew God, they did not glorify <i>Him</i> as God, nor were thankful, but became futile in their thoughts, and their foolish hearts were darkened. <sup>22</sup> Professing to be wise, they became fools, <sup>23</sup> and changed the glory of the incorruptible God into an image made like corruptible man—and birds and four-footed animals and creeping things.</p> <p><sup>24</sup> Therefore God also gave them up to uncleanness, in the lusts of their hearts, to dishonor their bodies among themselves, <sup>25</sup> who exchanged the truth of God for the lie, and worshiped and served the creature rather than the Creator, who is blessed forever. Amen.</p> <p><sup>26</sup> For this reason God gave them up to vile passions. For even their women exchanged the natural use for what is against nature.</p> <p><sup>27</sup> Likewise also the men, leaving the natural use of the woman, burned in their lust for one another, men with men committing what is shameful, and receiving in themselves the penalty of their error which was due.</p>

Bible	Text
Romans 1:18-32 (Continued)	<p><sup>28</sup> And even as they did not like to retain God in <i>their</i> knowledge, God gave them over to a debased mind, to do those things which are not fitting; <sup>29</sup> being filled with all unrighteousness, sexual immorality, <sup>[a]</sup> wickedness, covetousness, maliciousness; full of envy, murder, strife, deceit, evil-mindedness; <i>they are</i> whisperers, <sup>30</sup> backbiters, haters of God, violent, proud, boasters, inventors of evil things, disobedient to parents, <sup>31</sup> undiscerning, untrustworthy, unloving, unforgiving, <sup>[b]</sup> unmerciful; <sup>32</sup> who, knowing the righteous judgment of God, that those who practice such things are deserving of death, not only do the same but also approve of those who practice them.</p>
Romans 3:20	<p><sup>20</sup> Therefore by the deeds of the law no flesh will be justified in His sight, for by the law <i>is</i> the knowledge of sin.</p>
Romans 3:23-24	<p><sup>23</sup> for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, <sup>24</sup> being justified freely by His grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus,</p>
<b>Romans 6:15</b> (The Cross is no ticket to sinning)	<p><sup>15</sup> <b>What then? Shall we sin because we are not under law but under grace? Certainly not!</b></p>
<b>1 Corinthians 6:9-11</b> (Sins)	<p>9 Do you not know that the unrighteous will not inherit the kingdom of God? Do not be deceived. Neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor homosexuals,<sup>[a]</sup> nor sodomites, 10 nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners will inherit the kingdom of God. 11 And such were some of you. But you were washed, but you were sanctified, but you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus and by the Spirit of our God.</p>
<b>1 Corinthians 6:17-20</b> (Holy Spirit can only dwell in a clean temple)	<p><sup>17</sup> But he who is joined to the Lord is one spirit with Him. 18 Flee sexual immorality. Every sin that a man does is outside the body, but he who commits sexual immorality sins against his own body. 19 Or do you not know that your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you, whom you have from God, and you are not your own? 20 For you were bought at a price; therefore glorify God in your body<sup>[a]</sup> and in your spirit, which are God's.</p>
<b>Galatians 6:1</b> (Restoration of brethren)	<p>Brethren, if a man is overtaken in any trespass, you who <i>are</i> spiritual restore such a one in a spirit of gentleness, considering yourself lest you also be tempted.</p>
Ephesians 5:18	<p><sup>18</sup> And do not be drunk with wine, in which is dissipation; but be filled with the Spirit,</p>
Colossians 3:5	<p><sup>5</sup> Therefore put to death your members which are on the earth: fornication, uncleanness, passion, evil desire, and covetousness, which is idolatry.</p>
1 Timothy 1:8-11	<p><sup>8</sup> But we know that the law <i>is</i> good if one uses it lawfully, <sup>9</sup> knowing this: that the law is not made for a righteous person, but for <i>the</i> lawless and insubordinate, for <i>the</i> ungodly and for sinners, for <i>the</i> unholy and profane, for murderers of fathers and murderers of mothers, for manslayers,</p>

1 Timothy 1:8-11 (Continued)  <b>Hebrews 9:28</b> (2nd coming)	10 for fornicators, for sodomites, for kidnappers, for liars, for perjurers, and if there is any other thing that is contrary to sound doctrine, 11 according to the glorious gospel of the blessed God which was committed to my trust.  <sup>28</sup> so Christ was offered once to bear the sins of many. To those who eagerly wait for Him He will appear a second time, apart from sin, for salvation.
James 4:4	4 Adulterers and[a] adulteresses! Do you not know that friendship with the world is enmity with God? Whoever therefore wants to be a friend of the world makes himself an enemy of God.
James 4:8	<sup>8</sup> Draw near to God and He will draw near to you. Cleanse <i>your</i> hands, <i>you</i> sinners; and purify <i>your</i> hearts, <i>you</i> double-minded.
Revelation 21:8	8 But the cowardly, unbelieving,[a] abominable, murderers, sexually immoral, sorcerers, idolaters, and all liars shall have their part in the lake which burns with fire and brimstone, which is the second death.”
