

Repentance

Bible	Text
2 Chronicles 7:14	¹⁴ if My people who are called by My name will humble themselves, and pray and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin and heal their land.
Proverbs 28:13	He who covers his sins will not prosper, But whoever confesses and forsakes <i>them</i> will have mercy.
Ezekiel 18:32	³² For I have no pleasure in the death of one who dies,” says the Lord God. “Therefore turn and live!”
Matthew 3:8	⁸ Therefore bear fruits worthy of repentance,
Matthew 4:17	¹⁷ From that time Jesus began to preach and to say, “Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.”
Mark 1:15	¹⁵ and saying, “The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand. Repent, and believe in the gospel.”
Luke 3:8	⁸ Therefore bear fruits worthy of repentance, and do not begin to say to yourselves, ‘We have Abraham as <i>our</i> father.’ For I say to you that God is able to raise up children to Abraham from these stones.
Luke 5:32	³² I have not come to call <i>the</i> righteous, but sinners, to repentance.”
Luke 15:7 (Repentant sinner)	⁷ I say to you that likewise there will be more joy in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine just persons who need no repentance.
Luke 15:10 (Repentant sinner)	¹⁰ Likewise, I say to you, there is joy in the presence of the angels of God over one sinner who repents.”
John 3:20	For everyone practicing evil hates the light and does not come to the light, lest his deeds should be exposed.
John 5:14	Afterward Jesus found him in the temple, and said to him, “See, you have been made well. Sin no more, lest a worse thing come upon you.”
John 8:7-11	⁷ So when they continued asking Him, He raised Himself up ^[a] and said to them, “He who is without sin among you, let him throw a stone at her first.” ⁸ And again He stooped down and wrote on the ground. ⁹ Then those who heard <i>it</i> , being convicted by <i>their</i> conscience, ^[b] went out one by one, beginning with the oldest <i>even</i> to the last. And Jesus was left alone, and the woman standing in the midst. ¹⁰ When Jesus had raised Himself up and saw no one but the woman, He said to her, ^[c] “Woman, where are those accusers of yours? ^[d] Has no one condemned you?” ¹¹ She said, “No one, Lord.” And Jesus said to her, “Neither do I condemn you; go and ^[e] sin no more.”

2 Peter 3:9 (God's patience)	9 The Lord is not slack concerning His promise, as some count slackness, but is longsuffering toward us,[a] not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance.
Ephesians 4:28	28 Let him who stole steal no longer, but rather let him labor, working with his hands what is good, that he may have something to give him who has need.
