Bible	Text
Job 19:25	For I know <i>that</i> my Redeemer lives, And He shall stand at last on the earth;
Psalms 25:5	Lead me in Your truth and teach me, For You <i>are</i> the God of my salvation; On You I wait all the day.
Psalms 34:17-18	¹⁷ <i>The righteous</i> cry out, and the Lord hears, And delivers them out of all their troubles. ¹⁸ The Lord <i>is</i> near to those who have a broken heart, And saves such as have a contrite spirit.
Psalms 34:22	The Lord redeems the soul of His servants, And none of those who trust in Him shall be condemned.
Psalms 62:1	Truly my soul silently <i>waits</i> for God; From Him <i>comes</i> my salvation.
Isaiah 43:4	Since you were precious in My sight, You have been honored, And I have loved you; Therefore I will give men for you, And people for your life.

Isaiah 53 (continued)	<p>² For He shall grow up before Him as a tender plant, And as a root out of dry ground. He has no form or comeliness; And when we see Him, <i>There is</i> no beauty that we should desire Him.</p> <p>³ He is despised and rejected by men, A Man of sorrows and acquainted with grief. And we hid, as it were, <i>our</i> faces from Him; He was despised, and we did not esteem Him.</p> <p>⁴ Surely He has borne our griefs And carried our sorrows; Yet we esteemed Him stricken, Smitten by God, and afflicted.</p> <p>⁵ But He <i>was</i> wounded for our transgressions, <i>He was</i> bruised for our iniquities; The chastisement for our peace <i>was</i> upon Him, And by His stripes we are healed.</p> <p>⁶ All we like sheep have gone astray; We have turned, every one, to his own way; And the Lord has laid on Him the iniquity of us all.</p> <p>⁷ He was oppressed and He was afflicted, Yet He opened not His mouth; He was led as a lamb to the slaughter, And as a sheep before its shearers is silent, So He opened not His mouth.</p> <p>⁸ He was taken from prison and from judgment, And who will declare His generation? Isaiah 53 (continued)	<p>But with the rich at His death, Because He had done no violence, Nor <i>was any</i> deceit in His mouth. ¹⁰ Yet it pleased the Lord to bruise Him; He has put <i>Him</i> to grief. When You make His soul an offering for sin, He shall see <i>His</i> seed, He shall prolong <i>His</i> days, And the pleasure of the Lord shall prosper in His hand. 11 He shall see the labor of His soul, and be satisfied. By His knowledge My righteous Servant shall justify many, For He shall bear their iniquities. ¹² Therefore I will divide Him a portion with the great, And He shall divide the spoil with the strong, Because He poured out His soul unto death, And He was numbered with the transgressors, And He bore the sin of many, And made intercession for the transgressors.</p>

Isaiah 57:15	<p>For thus says the High and Lofty One Who inhabits eternity, whose name <i>is</i> Holy: “<i>I</i> dwell in the high and holy <i>place</i>, With him <i>who</i> has a contrite and humble spirit, To revive the spirit of the humble, And to revive the heart of the contrite ones.</p>
Matthew 7:13-14	<p>13 “Enter by the narrow gate; for wide is the gate and broad is the way that leads to destruction, and there are many who go in by it. 14 Because[a] narrow is the gate and difficult is the way which leads to life, and there are few who find it.</p>

Matthew 16:25	²⁵ For whoever desires to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for My sake will find it.
Mark 8:35	³⁵ For whoever desires to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for My sake and the gospel's will save it.

Romans 1:16	¹⁶ For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ, for it is the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes, for the Jew first and also for the Greek.

Romans 1:17	¹⁷ For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith to faith; as it is written, "The just shall live by faith."
Romans 3:21-31	<p>21 But now the righteousness of God apart from the law is revealed, being witnessed by the Law and the Prophets, 22 even the righteousness of God, through faith in Jesus Christ, to all and on all[a] who believe. For there is no difference; 23 for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, 24 being justified freely by His grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus, 25 whom God set forth as a propitiation by His blood, through faith, to demonstrate His righteousness, because in His forbearance God had passed over the sins that were previously committed, 26 to demonstrate at the present time His righteousness, that He might be just and the justifier of the one who has faith in Jesus.</p> <p>²⁷ Where <i>is</i> boasting then? It is excluded. By what law? Of works? No, but by the law of faith. 28 Therefore we conclude that a man is justified by faith apart from the deeds of the law. 29 Or is He the God of the Jews only? Is He not also the God of the Gentiles? Yes, of the Gentiles also, 30 since there is one God who will justify the circumcised by faith and the uncircumcised through faith. 31 Do we then make void the law through faith? Certainly not! On the contrary, we establish the law.</p>
Romans 5:7-8	⁷ For scarcely for a righteous man will one die; yet perhaps for a good man someone would even dare to die. ⁸ But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.
Romans 5:10	¹⁰ For if when we were enemies we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, much more, having been reconciled, we shall be saved by His life.
Romans 5:19	¹⁹ For as by one man's disobedience many were made sinners, so also by one Man's obedience many will be made righteous.
Romans 10:9-10	9 that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. 10 For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.
Romans 10:13	¹³ For "whoever calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved."
Romans 10:17	¹⁷ So then faith <i>comes</i> by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.
1 Corinthians 1:18	¹⁸ For the message of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God.
1 Corinthians 15:22	²² For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ all shall be made alive.
2 Corinthians 5:19	¹⁹ that is, that God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself, not imputing their trespasses to them, and has committed to us the word of reconciliation.

Ephesians 2:8-9	⁸ For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; <i>it is</i> the gift of God, ⁹ not of works, lest anyone should boast.
1 Thessalonians 4:16-17	¹⁶ For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of an archangel, and with the trumpet of God. And the dead in Christ will rise first. ¹⁷ Then we who are alive <i>and</i> remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And thus we shall always be with the Lord.
2 Timothy 1:9	⁹ who has saved us and called <i>us</i> with a holy calling, not according to our works, but according to His own purpose and grace which was given to us in Christ Jesus before time began,
Titus 2:11-12	¹¹ For the grace of God that brings salvation has appeared to all men, ¹² teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly in the present age,
Hebrews 5:9	⁹ And having been perfected, He became the author of eternal salvation to all who obey Him,
Hebrews 7:25 (Christ)	²⁵ Therefore He is also able to save to the uttermost those who come to God through Him, since He always lives to make intercession for them.
Hebrews 9:28	²⁸ so Christ was offered once to bear the sins of many. To those who eagerly wait for Him He will appear a second time, apart from sin, for salvation.
James 1:21	²¹ Therefore lay aside all filthiness and overflow of wickedness, and receive with meekness the implanted word, which is able to save your souls.
1 Peter 1:8-9	8 whom having not seen[a] you love. Though now you do not see Him, yet believing, you rejoice with joy inexpressible and full of glory, 9 receiving the end of your faith—the salvation of your souls.
1 John 4:4	⁴ You are of God, little children, and have overcome them, because He who is in you is greater than he who is in the world.
1 John 5:12	¹² He who has the Son has life; he who does not have the Son of God does not have life.
